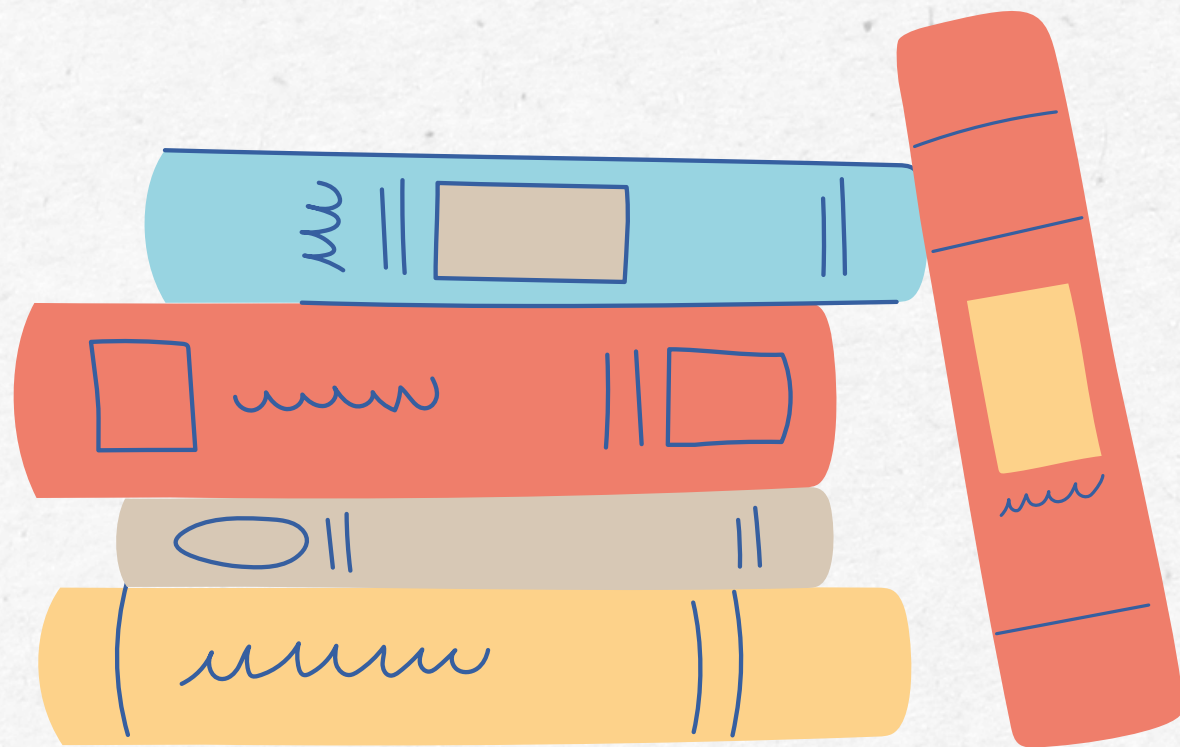

CAPSTONE PROJECT

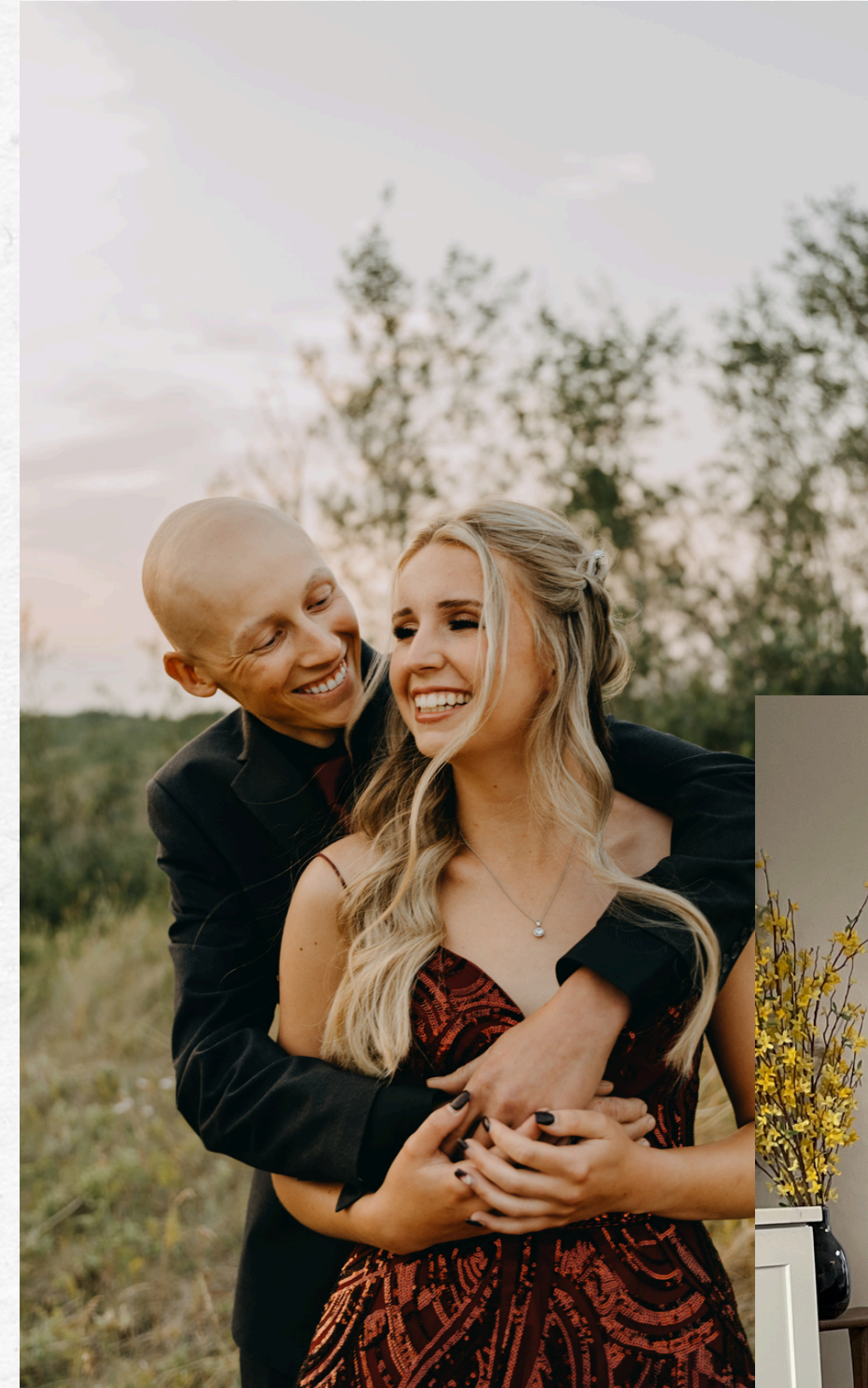


- Great way to try the careers you are thinking about going into.
